
Yet again I've got to say a big thank you to the Gillbard family for the use of the land and also thank you to our sponsors, committee members and helpers.

Paul Sturrock (aka Luggy) Former Football Manager and player. As a football player, Paul Sturrock spent his entire senior career with Dundee United, making more than five hundred appearances between 1974 and 1989 before he went into management. Sturrock's managerial career began with St Johnstone in 1993, Dundee United and then Plymouth Argyle where he helped the club to win two promotions before moving on to a brief spell with Southampton. He has subsequently also managed Sheffield Wednesday, Swindon Town and Southend United as well as returning to Plymouth for a second spell. According to an analysis by the Financial Times he was among the country's best ever managers.

What's Happening

The Great Trethew Vintage Rally is an annual three-day not for profit event that takes place on 26th, 27th & 28th of August at Horningtops, Liskeard Cornwall. PL14 3PZ. A great day out for all the family over the three days of the August bank holiday weekend. Exhibits & displays consist of classic vehicles, tractors, motorcycles, steam and stationary engines, horticultural equipment, tractor pulling, commercial and military vehicle displays, organised parades and demonstrations in the main show ring. There is lots of entertainment in display areas such as Wild West re-enactment, tractor pulling, working horses, traditional craft demonstrations, a live music stage & a dog show.

We have a dedicated Children's area with face painters, children's entertainers and vintage fairground attractions. Trade stands & a craft marquee will be selling a variety of items from bric-a-brac to clothing and handcrafted must haves. There are refreshments, caterers and a licensed bar on site with live music on Saturday & Sunday evening.



The Great Trethew Rally was founded in November 2016 by the late Mike Elford, who unfortunately passed during 2018.

Mike was a local farmer and keen vintage rally man, having been involved with the Morval Rally for many years. He also kept and showed Shire Horses.



At the cessation of Morval Rally, which was set up by a few locals to raise funds for the church roof 40 years previously; Mike was keen to keep the rally going. He approached his one time neighbours the Gillbard family about using the land at Great Trethew. A meeting was held to appoint secretary's, showyard directors etc. We still have Angie Kurn as our tractor secretary and Paul Lloyd as our steam secretary. The first Great Trethew Rally was held on

August bank holiday weekend 2017. It was a very hot weekend and a successful one which encouraged us all to carry on.

We hope you all enjoy your visit with us at Great Trethew and we look forward to carry on Mike's vision.





Built in 1937 Works No 88097. New to R Dingle & Son Ltd of Stoke Climsland & delivered by rail to Bodmin where it worked in and around the town. It made it's first preservation appearance at Dingles Centenary Rally in 1985, following this it was fully restored by it's custodians the Morcom family of Mitchell. The last of the derelict engines in the Dingles yard to be saved. Displayed at the Steam Museum for many years until sold at auction in 2005, it's only had two owners from new! Fitted with refurbished canopy in 2016 & sign written by Amy Goodwin. New To Mr Honey of North Devon for threshing on 3rd September 1900. Her driver Mr Ivey of Black Torrington / Hatherleigh area later bought her for much the same duties as well as some general haulage. The late Hedley James bought her for preservation on the advice of a friend called Bill Moore. The unusual name comes from a Davey Paxman engine that he remembers as a boy working in his home area of Indian Queens.

A new rear axle with wheel bushes has been fitted and the winding drum/ brake gear assembly bushed, the front axle has been made true and wheel/ pivot pin bushes renewed. The spud pan taken off in 1957 is a feature re attached to the engine. Tyrone now has sons involved in maintaining "Little Audrey" this will see three generations of the same family running 34022 over a period of 67 years.


